


Lost a Pet?

On any given day, Rochester Animal Services (RAS) may have 50-100 cats and dogs onsite or in foster care. Owners can visit the facility anytime during our regular business hours to check for their missing pets and to file Lost Pet Reports. However, we support finders who are willing to assist with pet reunification so your pet may still be in your neighborhood.



There are a variety of ways you can locate your lost pet and get it back home as quickly as possible.

1. Check your neighborhood and knock on doors

Most missing pets are found by their owners or Good Samaritans in their own neighborhoods. Walk the neighborhood, knock on doors, and ask people who you encounter if they may have seen your pet. Cell phone photos of your pet will help.

2. Check City website

Visit cityofrochester.gov/lostapet to search listings for animals in the Animal Services Center or the City's pet foster care program

3. File a Lost Pet Report

Call 585-428-7274 to file a report over the phone or submit report online at cityofrochester.gov/lostapet

4. Visit the shelter

Check the Animal Services Center at 184 Verona Street during regular business hours to see if your pet may be there, review Found Pet Reports, and to submit or update a Lost Pet Report. Bring photos and vaccination records.

5. Gather photos

Gather several photos of your pet that best illustrate what it looked like when it went missing. Use the photos on Lost Pet Flyers, Lost Pet Reports, and social media posts.

6. Post on social media

Post description of your missing pet, photos, and location on social media sites like Craigslist, Facebook and Nextdoor.

7. Make and Post Flyers

Hang flyers in heavy traffic areas and public spaces near where your pet was last seen. Good old fashioned leg work is still the best way to locate a missing pet.

8. Use Online Tools

Use lost.petcolove.org and PetFBI.org to expand your search through those online databases. Petco Love Lost uses facial recognition to match photos of your missing pet with photos of pets found in your community.



How to Post Lost Pet on Craigslist

Select [community] and click continue


please limit each posting to a single area and category, once per 48 hours




Choose a category: select [pets] and click continue.



Fill out the following format (Green fields are required). Answer to the best of your ability. An email address is required. You can opt to not have emails sent but options are available to provide your direct phone number and address.



Provide a zip code and press [continue].




You can add images of your missing pet. Once completed, select [done with images].



Review your post finalize any information then select [publish]. Once you select [publish] the post will publicly be published on Craigslist.

Note* A craigslist post only last for 45 days.

Post on Lollypop Spotters page



Post on Lost, Found, Missing Pets Rochester NY and surrounding areas page

Go to https://www.facebook.com/groups/Lost.Found.Missing.pets/



Write a post including the description of the lost pet and location where last seen. Include your contact information unless you prefer to have communications occur through Facebook and Facebook Messenger. Click Photo/Video to add photos or video of your pet. Once the written post is completed and the photos/videos are uploaded, click Post.
