Blue Cross Arena is ADA compliant. Seating is available for wheelchair patrons throughout the venue.

Building Rental Period: Normal license agreement is based on a 3 ½ hour performance but can be altered to accommodate a longer event.

Concessions / Catering: Delaware North Companies – Contact Event Manager for Catering Contacts.

Doors Open: 60 minutes prior to ticketed show time.

Fire Prevention / Floor Plans: All floor plans must be submitted 30 days prior to on sale for approval by the Fire Marshal. Local law requires 7 square feet per person for a GA Floor.

Merchandise: Blue Cross Arena supplies stands and staff.

Pyrotechnics: City of Rochester/Monroe County Permits Required

Ten (10) follow spots are available for a center show, 8 for an end stage show. Each spot location has one light per basket. Arena spotlights are in permanent fixed locations and are unable to be moved.

Fourteen Telex headsets connect with ten spot stations, the sound booth, and three portable stations throughout the Arena.




Arena Audio System

- The Arena is equipped with a state-of-the-art sound system in the seating area and concourses. The system can be zoned and distributed to different areas of the building.
 - o Microphones, stands and basic audio services are provided in-house.
- This sound system is suitable for announcements and music during sporting events and reinforcement of live speech and musical events.
- Arena Bowl contains nine main speaker clusters designed by Fulcrum Acoustics. It is approximately 40' feet from the arena floor to the bottom of the speaker clusters.
- The 70-volt distributed sound system services all levels of the arena, including event level, concourse, and suites. Each room has an individual control for manual volume override
- The system is powered and operated from the Suite Level Sound and Lighting booth.



Broadcast Control Room

Load-In

Blue Cross Arena has (4) loading dock bays. The loading dock is at standard tractor trailer height and have adjustable loading ramps.

It is approximately 60' from the loading dock to the End Stage position on the arena floor.

Blue Cross Arena has (1) accessible loading bay door at Grade/Event level.

Stagehands

IATSE Stagehands – Blue Cross Arena has a working agreement with IATSE Local 25. All needs should be coordinated with Event Manager. There is a 4-hour minimum for all load in crews, except for Riggers, who have a 5-hour minimum on the Load In. All load out crew have a 5-hour minimum, if the 5th hour is a working hour over time rates apply. All staff must be cut or fed at the end of any continuous working period of four (4) hours. If eating period is not taken, impacted employees will receive an additional hour of pay at the prevailing rate. A minimum of 4 heads will remain on throughout the event (Steward, Electrician, 2 Hands). All arena events also include house light operator, and sound man if any portion of Arena system is being used (PA, Intercom). Sundays are paid at an Overtime Rate.

IATSE Wardrobe – Blue Cross Arena has a working agreement with IATSE Local 858. All needs should be coordinated with the Event Manager. There is a 4-hour minimum for all load in and load out crews. Staff must be cut or fed at the end of any continuous working period of four (4) hours. If eating period is not taken, impacted employees will receive an additional hour of pay at the prevailing rate. Sundays are paid at an Overtime Rate

Freight Elevator

One (1) 8,000lb capacity freight elevator is located near the loading dock. This elevator accesses the basement, event, and concourse levels. Forklifts are unable to be used on the elevator.


Rigging

Arena Rigging

Open steel throughout the Arena. Low steel is 44 feet from the floor. Maximum two tons per 27-foot span. Maximum 1.75 tons per 0-feet of catwalk parallel to the truss. No load should be attached to any components of the catwalk.

** All events with 90,000 lbs. or more of rigging will be subject to an Engineer's Analysis.

Minimum rigging call is 3 up, 1 down in case bridling of points is required



Equipment

Basketball Court

Court with NBA, NCAA, High School markings available.

Concert Barricade

Manufacturer – R.A. Reed. The self-supporting concert barricade has eight sections of blow through style and 16 sections solid. Quantity includes twenty 4' sections, maximum of 80' wide.

Concert Stage

Manufacturer - StageRight stage Model #ME3750. The rolling concert stage is 80'x80' with skirting and handrails. Heights from 4' to 6' can be built in any 4'x8' dimension as well as tiered in different heights.

Forklifts

Three Yale forklifts each have a 5,000 lb. capacity and standard forks. Additional lifts or extensions can be arranged through Event Manager and billed at settlement. Forklifts operated by IATSE 25 staff, and must be included in event labor call

Hockey Rink/Astro Turf

Athletica 200' x 85' dasher and acrylic 590 system. Fourteen rolls of Turf Nation carpet with NLL Lacrosse markings also available.

Ice Deck

The Ice Pro ice deck covers 200'x85'.

Mixer Risers

The gray carpeted 4'x8' mixer risers all interlock. The three different leg sizes include 8", 16", and 24", all 18 in quantity.

Scissor Lift

Seating Risers

Manufactured by StageRight. One end court seating riser is 7 tiered 56'x28'. The Arena also has two side court seating risers, two tiered, at 96'x8'.

Tables & Chairs

The Arena has thirty-six 72" round tables, eighty-four 8'x3'x30" tables, and twelve 3'10"x 8'x 30" banquet tables. Two hundred fifty chairs can accompany any layout.
