



South Clinton Avenue, East Broad Street Convert to Two-Way Traffic on Thursday

(Friday, Oct. 12, 2018) -- Portions of South Clinton Avenue and East Broad Street in Downtown Rochester will convert to two-way traffic starting Thursday, Oct. 18.

Re-striping activities will take place on the roadways at South Clinton Avenue from I-490 to East Main Street; and East Broad Street from South Clinton Avenue to South Avenue on Thursday, Oct. 18, and motorists may experience delays while this work is being completed.

Once striping is completed:

- East Broad Street will be open to two-way traffic between South Avenue and South Clinton Avenue;
- South Clinton Avenue will be open to two-way traffic between East Main Street and East Broad Street; and
- South Clinton Avenue will remain one-way from I-490 to East Broad Street.

Flaggers will be at both ends of the new two-way sections of the streets to guide traffic and will remain in place for 1 hour following the striping. At that point, motorists will need to follow the traffic signals and striping.

The rain date for this work is Friday.
