#### **HELPFUL INFORMATION:**

If a property is located within a preservation district, is a designated building of historic value or is a landmark, a Certificate of Appropriateness may be required from the Preservation Board.

- ✓ Insurance Certificates (see attached)

# **ROOFS and RE-ROOFS**

## **Helpful Information:**

- A roof re-cover shall not be permitted where any of the following conditions exists:
  - > The roof or roof covering is water soaked or has deteriorated to the point that the existing roof cover is not adequate as a base for additional roofing.
  - > The existing roof covering is slate, clay, cement or asbestos-cement tile.
  - ➤ The existing roof has two or more applications of any type of roof covering.
- If a property is located within a preservation district, is a designated building of historic value or is a landmark, a Certificate of Appropriateness may be required from the Preservation Board.

## **WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE**

The State of New York requires that, prior to issuing any permits, the City of Rochester be provided with proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage **or** provide proof of exemption from such coverage.

One of the following certificates must be provided by the applicant with each permit request:

- C105.2 or U-26.2 Workers' Compensation Insurance (private carrier) (contractor with employees)
- CE-200 Exemption Certificate (contractor with no employees)
- BP-1 Affidavit of Exemption
   (owner occupied 1-4 family & owner is performing work)
- SI12 or GSI-105.2 Self Insurance coverage

## Helpful Hints:

- To obtain a CE 200 Exemption

  - ➤ Worker's Compensation Board location at 130 W. Main Street (verify if open by calling 1-877-632-4996)
- Certificates for building permits are job-specific and a separate certificate will be required for each building permit.
- NYS does NOT accept "ACORD" Certificates nor will they accept faxed copies.
