	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ This Project consists of the realignment of Dewey Avenue, between Lexington Avenue to Selye Terrace. ■ The scope of the work consists of full depth reconstruction of Dewey Avenue and Driving Park Avenue. New curbs, sidewalks, new signal, drainage improvements, street lights, and parklet construction. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The scope also includes water main replacement and sanitary sewer replacement. ■ Bike lanes will be installed on Dewey Avenue within the project limits. ■ Pavement markings, signs and landscaping will also be included in the project.
Current Construction Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Lighttower Fiber Optic completed relocation of their facilities. ■ Areaways at 343 Driving Park Avenue (Maplewood Books Bldg.) has been removed and backfilled. ■ RG&E Gas installing new gas main along south side of Driving Park Avenue at Broezel Street. 	
Upcoming Construction Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ RG&E Gas to continue installation of new gas main along the north and south side of Driving Park Avenue from Broezel Street to Straub Street. ■ RG&E Gas to install individual gas services. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ RG&E Gas work is scheduled to be completed in late December. ■ Ramsey Constructors anticipated to resume construction in March of 2018.
