





Recreation's Youth Council Makes a Difference Every Day!

Our mission is to make Rochester a better place to live.

And as a YVOV member, you'll plan service projects, make decisions collectively, and find solutions to many wide ranging issues that effect your community. We work in collaboration with other youth across the county and local officials to develop ideas and programs to improve our community.

We meet the last Tuesday of each month at 6 pm. Locations alternate across the Rochester area. Youth, adults, groups and other community organizations are all welcome. At these meetings, you will experience being a member of a powerful young team.



Y.E.S. is about YOU and YOUR ideas for service learning based projects.

Y.E.S. stands for Youth Engaged with Service.

The Y.E.S. Committee is a youth-led service learning collaboration between Youth Voice, One Vision, Youth As Resources and the Nazareth College Center for Service Learning. Y.E.S. brings youth, adults, and

community agencies together to collaborate on service learning projects in our communities. The committee meets bi-weekly, plans 2-3 citywide service learning projects, and provides youth-led Service Learning workshops in order to promote and practice the tenets of quality, youth driven service learning throughout Monroe County. Past service projects include the MLK Skate to Commemorate, the "From Roc to Riverton" Global Youth Service Day, and the Cardboard City Lock-Out.



Girls Coalition

The Girls Coalition brings together "positive girls doing positive things" from South Ave, Campbell St., Gantt (North St.), Ryan, Avenue D, Edgerton, and Flint St. Community Centers. The girls meet with trained professional staff on a weekly basis at their center and then come together as a city-wide *Girls Coalition* once a month to empower and provide resources to female youth leaders. The coalition is a partnership between Recreation and Nazareth College Center for Service Learning.

Positive Tickets

In 2008, Youth Voice, One Vision launched Positive Ticket youth and adult patrols to catch people doing something good! conferences, participate as "youth experts" on local panels, and frequently attend forums and events sponsored by partner agencies.

The Steppin' Up To Solutions Conference was established and facilitated by YVOV. This conference is an opportunity for youth to attend interactive workshops and create youth-led projects to address issues or concerns in our city and towns. At the all-day summit, youth identify issues of concern and collectively develop real and practical solutions. To date, we have sponsored and participated in over a dozen conferences.

Youth Philanthropy

YVOV has teamed up with the **Youth as Resources (YAR)** Board, coordinated by the Rochester Monroe County Youth Bureau, to support the philanthropic efforts of the *Steppin' Up To Solutions* Conference. YAR provides technical and financial support to the youth-led solutions and projects created at the conference. The board annually distributes \$20,000 for community service projects.
