WHEN PULLED OVER:

- If dark out, turn dome light on
- Put visor down
- Roll down window
- Stay in your car, place your hands on steering wheel and wait for the officer
- Point to Visor Alert and self, hand this card to the officer if necessary
- Indicate to the officer where you are reaching (for license and registration)

I COMMUNICATE USING THESE METHODS

- 1. American Sign Language
- 2. Pen/paper/texting
- 3. Lipreading
- 4. Verbal communication

HERE'S HOW YOU CAN HELP ME UNDERSTAND YOU

- 1. Try to eliminate background noise
- 2. Do not cover your mouth with hand or paper
- 3. Do not shout, use a normal tone
- 4. Speak slowly and clearly
- 5. Do not shine flashlight in eyes

TIPS FOR USING THIS VISOR ALERT

- Use a binder clip to attach this Visor Alert to your vehicle sun visor
- Assist the police by staying calm and cooperating. Police need to be in control of the situation
- If requested, hand the officer your license and registration
