roject Descriptio

- This Project consists of the realignment of Dewey Avenue, between Lexington Avenue to Selye Terrace.
- The scope of the work consists of full depth reconstruction of Dewey Avenue and Driving Park Avenue. New curbs, sidewalks, new signal, drainage improvements, street lights, and parklet construction.
- The scope also includes water main replacement and sanitary sewer replacement.
- Bike lanes will be installed on Dewey Avenue within the project limits.
- Pavement markings, signs and landscaping will also be included in the project.

Current Construction Activity

- Watermain replacement has begun at Driving Park @ Straub Street and will continue to Broezel Street.
- Began installation of drainage for new alignment of Dewey Avenue from Driving Park to Selye Terrace.



Upcoming Sonstruction Activity

 Begin excavation and installation of new alignment of Dewey Avenue from Driving Park to Selye Terrace.
