IIA. General Project Description for Rehabilitation:

- Roadway milling and resurfacing
- New stone curbing with underdrain system
- Spot replacement of broken and hazardous concrete sidewalks
- Installation of accessible ramps
- Carriage walks:
Will be removed for properties with legal driveways
Properties without driveways will have their carriage walk replaced
- Existing parking regulations will remain on Cottage Street
- Restoration of grass areas affected by the construction;
- New street trees (installed by City Forestry after project completion);

- Utility Work
 - Water: replacement of lead and galvanized water services and valves;
 - RG&E (Gas & Electric) – utility adjustments
 - City Street Lighting – New LED light fixtures, potential light pole relocation along Magnolia Street, light level assessment in front of School #19
 - TWC and Frontier - utility adjustments
 - Monroe County Pure Waters - Drainage inlet repairs/replacements where needed

IIB. Seward Street

- Existing Conditions – April 2018

Summer 2018 Construction Projects

- Reynolds – Seward Street Rehabilitation Project *Completed Fall 2018*
 - Bump-in parking on Reynolds Street adjacent to School #19
- RCSD School #19 Improvements *Completed Summer 2019*
 - Parking Lot reconfiguration to accommodate school bus drop off/loading
 - Decreased Bump-in drop off area in front of school

Proposed Plans

- Seward Street one-way conversion – from Reynolds Street to Magnolia Street (pending City Council approval)
 - Endorsed by Monroe County DOT since 2000
 - Recommended by Safe Routes to School Action Plan July 2009
 - MCDOT September 2019 Traffic Observations completed – continued one-way conversion recommendation
 - Remove north bound slip ramp (right turn lane)
 - Raise Crosswalk at Reynolds/Seward intersection

III. Maintenance of Traffic

- Two-way traffic will be maintained, using flag persons when necessary.
- Some driveway access disruptions during curb, sidewalk and driveway placement.
