USEPA BROWNFIELD MULTIPURPOSE GRANT APPLICATION

- Up to \$800,000 GRANT
 - City pursuing Grant (application deadline is October 28, 2020)
 - •The Bull's Head Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA)/Bull's Head Revitalization Project area is targeted by the City for this EPA Grant application
 - Only 10 EPA Brownfield Multipurpose Grants are anticipated to be awarded nationwide
 - •5% City match
 - •To be used for environmental assessment and/or cleanup of at least two City-owned parcels within the project area:
 - -42 York Street
 - -835-855 West Main Street

42 York Street

- 0.48-acre parcel
- Currently an unused paved open parking lot.
- Formerly residential with parking of numerous vehicles, apparent dark staining and presence of miscellaneous items.
- Acquired by City in 2016.
- Contains fill material, including ash layers that are considered a non-hazardous industrial regulated solid waste.
- Fill and soil contaminated with heavy metals and semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs).
- Further assessment and cleanup using Grant funds planned to assist redevelopment.



The City was recently awarded an EPA Environmental Brownfield Cleanup Grant for 24 and 32 York Street

835-855 West Main Street

- 4.22-Acre Parcel
- Currently <u>Bull's Head Plaza</u> (85,599 SF Building and Paved Open Parking Lot).
- Former uses include laundry, dry cleaners, machine shop, auto sales, machine manufacturer.
- Acquired by City in 2018.
- Soil and groundwater contaminated with chlorinated volatile organic compounds (CVOCs).
- Fill and Soil contaminated with heavy metals and SVOCs.
- Critical environmental assessment planned using Grant funds, which will assist City with future remedial planning, cleanup and redevelopment.
