

**PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE LAW – SECTION 24**

Proclamation of Local State of Emergency:

Due to the December 21, 2022 catastrophic water main break in the vicinity of Ford Street and West Main Street and significant flooding resulting therefrom; and in consideration of the winter storm warning issued by the National Weather Service forecasting an impending winter storm in the Rochester area that is predicted to bring frigid temperatures, heavy snow and strong winds from December 23 to December 25, 2022, in order to address the threat to public health and safety that the flooding and the storm present,

I hereby proclaim a local State of Emergency as follows:

This State of Emergency shall take effect on **December 22, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.** throughout the City of Rochester.

Pursuant to this Emergency Proclamation, I expect to issue necessary Emergency Orders as appropriate to address the unfolding emergencies. Such Emergency Orders may provide for:

- establishment of a curfew, controlling pedestrian and/or vehicular traffic throughout the City or in certain areas of the City;
- designation of specific zones within which the occupancy and use of buildings and the ingress and egress of vehicles and persons may be prohibited or regulated;
- regulation and closing of places of amusement and assembly;
- suspension or limitation of the sale, dispensing, use or transportation of alcoholic beverages, firearms, explosives, and flammable materials and liquids
- prohibition and control of the presence of persons on public streets and places
- establishment or designation of emergency shelters;
- any other actions calculated to protect life and property or to bring the emergency situation under control.
